1. EXAM LOCATION

- Exams will be written in your regular classroom. Please confirm the room with your teacher.
- Students with exam conflicts or requiring special consideration will write exams in the conflict room L30.

2. <u>ATTENDANCE</u>

- If you miss an exam without prior permission from the office, you will receive a zero unless you provide a medical certificate.
- No extra time will be allowed to students who arrive late. If you are <u>less than 15 minutes late</u>, you are to report directly to your exam room. If you are <u>more than 15 minutes late</u>, you are to report to the office to see the Vice Principal.
- Phone calls home regarding student absence from exams will be made by exam supervisors.

3. <u>RESTRICTIONS IN THE EXAM ROOM</u>

- Students must not bring food, drinks, coats, hats, backpacks, paper or binders into the exam room.
- Cell phones, mp3 players, iPod, iPad, cameras, electronic devices or anything else deemed not appropriate must not be brought into the exam room.
- Purses or pencil cases must be placed under chairs.
- Students must remain in the exam room for a <u>minimum of one hour</u>. Breaks are not permitted.
- Students must leave the building and not hang out in the hallways once their exam is complete.

4. <u>TUTORIALS</u>

- Extra help with courses is available. Talk to your teacher as to when they will be available.

6. <u>TEXTBOOKS AND COURSE MATERIALS</u>

- **All textbooks and course materials** must be handed in to your teacher in the exam room before the exam is written. You will not receive any textbooks for your semester two classes, if you have any outstanding textbooks from your semester one classes.
