-EQAO literacy results amazing for Grade 10 (87%). Hammarskjold has scored highest in the city. Math percentage is low, but has increased from previous year. -Hammarskjold is piloting EQAO literacy testing online. If students do well, it counts. If they do poorly, it doesn't. Literacy test will be October 20th. -Sports – JR & SR football has lots of kids. Superior kids have been invited to joing our team due to low numbers at their school. JR team won tonight! Cross country running has 50+ kids. Golf team will be going to Geraldton with Mr. Letwin. JR & SR girls basketball has started, as well as JR & SR boys volleyball and midget badminton

-Budget – \$500 School Council approved again + \$746 still available from last year = \$1246
-PA Day September 30th
-PEP Rally coming up next Friday at lunch. Superior football kids to be invited to come as well, with their school flag
-Communication with parents needs to improve. Various communication systems discussed (facebook, twitter, synervoice, Remind101).
