1. Welcome and Introduction

Principal Derek DiBlasio welcomed everyone to the meeting.

2. <u>Review and Approval of Agenda</u>

3. <u>Review and Approval of Minutes</u>

Minutes were reviewed and approved by Rob Thibodeau, seconded by Heather Laur

4. Current Issues/Concerns

- When a threat is received, a decision needs to be made quickly with the Principal and Superintendent and Director of Education regarding whether to close the school or to put the school into lockdown or hold and secure. This partly depends on the time that the threat was received.
- Thunder Bay Police and/or Tactical Team has attended each time. Staff needs to follow their procedures to ensure student and staff safety.
- Empty lockers have all had locks put on them, including the ones in the bathrooms and staff room
- As well as our full time Guidance Counsellors, a full time social worker and additional support workers from Superior and a Mental Health Lead have been brought in to support students. If necessary, we could also ask the Westgate social worker to come to Hammarskjold.
- External people from Thunder Bay Counselling Centre are also available for Group or Individual Counselling outside of the school for those uncomfortable speaking to someone within the school.
- Therapy dogs have been to the school to visit with students.
- Staff have been debriefed after each incident
- We are trying to support students and staff, as well as Thunder Bay Police
- Actions are based on specificity of each threat
- We are reacting on the basis of specificity
- We will continue to base decisions on student safety

- Tip line has been set up Call 684-5001 with any information
- A \$5000 Reward is now being offered by Lakehead Public Schools
- Crimestoppers is also offering a \$1000 Reward
- This is a very awkward situation
- Other steps being taken include the Board deciding to pay for police presence at all three secondary high schools on a rotating schedule
- There are three levels of security that can be implemented during a crisis
- 1) **Shelter in Place** Stay indoors, turn off cell phones and remain in place until Shelter in Place is lifted
- 2) Hold and Secure Stay indoors, close and lock all windows and doors, stay away from doors and windows, turn off cell phones and remain in place until Hold and Secure is lifted
- 3) Lockdown As in Hold and Secure, plus turn off all lights and maintain silence and remain in place until released by Police Services.
- IT specialist will be coming into Hammarskjold twice within the next week to put stuff online so students/parents can see assignments to be done or other messages, etc.
- Any suggestions that anyone might have to help are welcomed
- Upcoming parent meeting for people to ask questions or for us provide any new information that we are able to discuss without compromising the investigation
- Hoping to give out counselling resources and information to parents and students at upcoming meeting
